1.1 Overview




Figure 1. Document library



Regarding the WBP beta version, the colleagues from EU CENTRE, that unfortunately were not able to attend the meeting, will be asked to send the update of the new versions of the WBP with eventual comments from other participants that were collected in the meantime. Brief discussion was initiated by Prof.Dr.Markel Baballeku about the adopted fragility curves for bridges and the fact that each of the cross-border countries involved has there own, already developed fragility curves for certain bridge types. Prof.Baballeku suggested those curves to be proposed in D4.2 as an addition, beside the harmonized models from EU CENTRE. It was agreed this to be pointed out in
